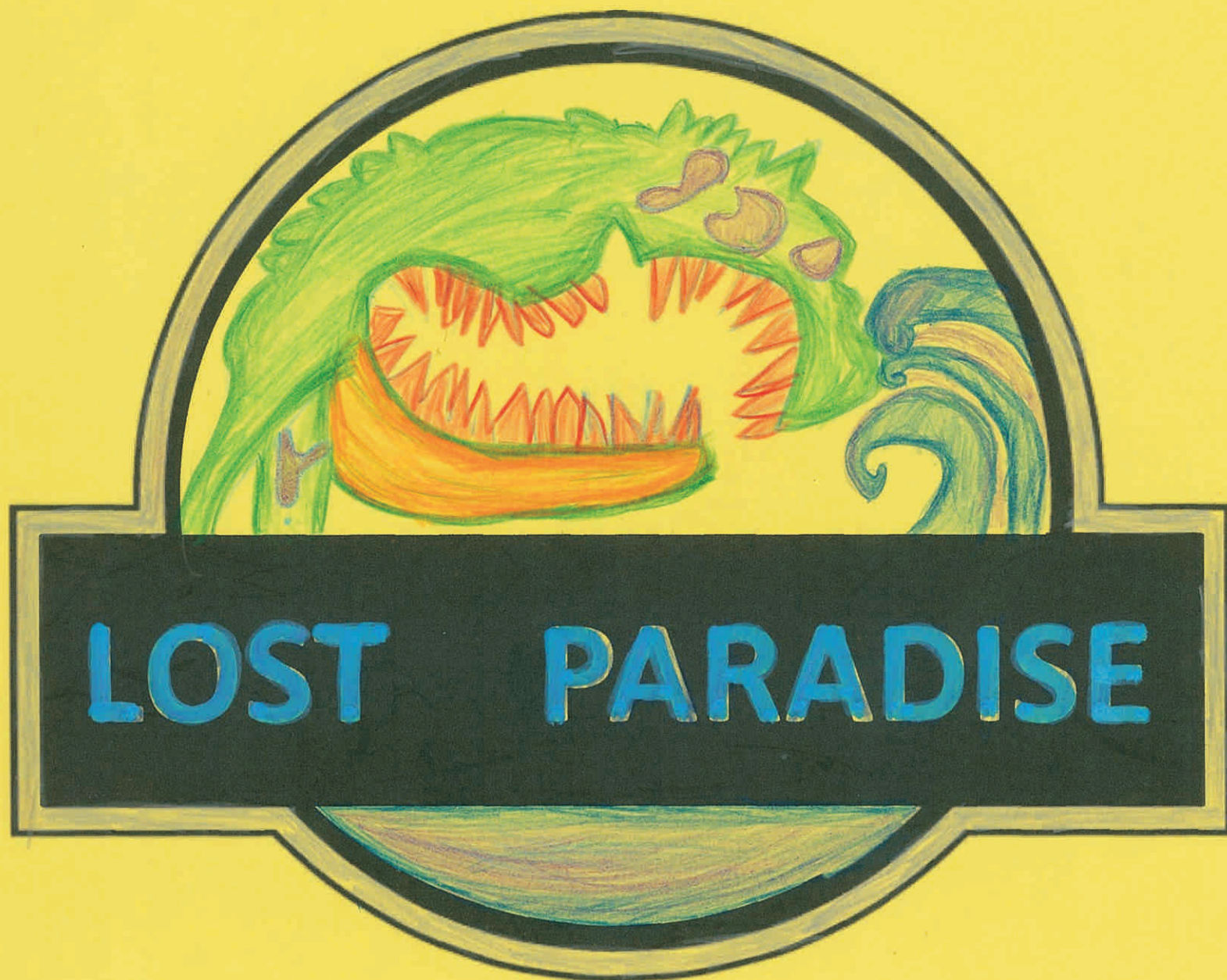

I can fly.



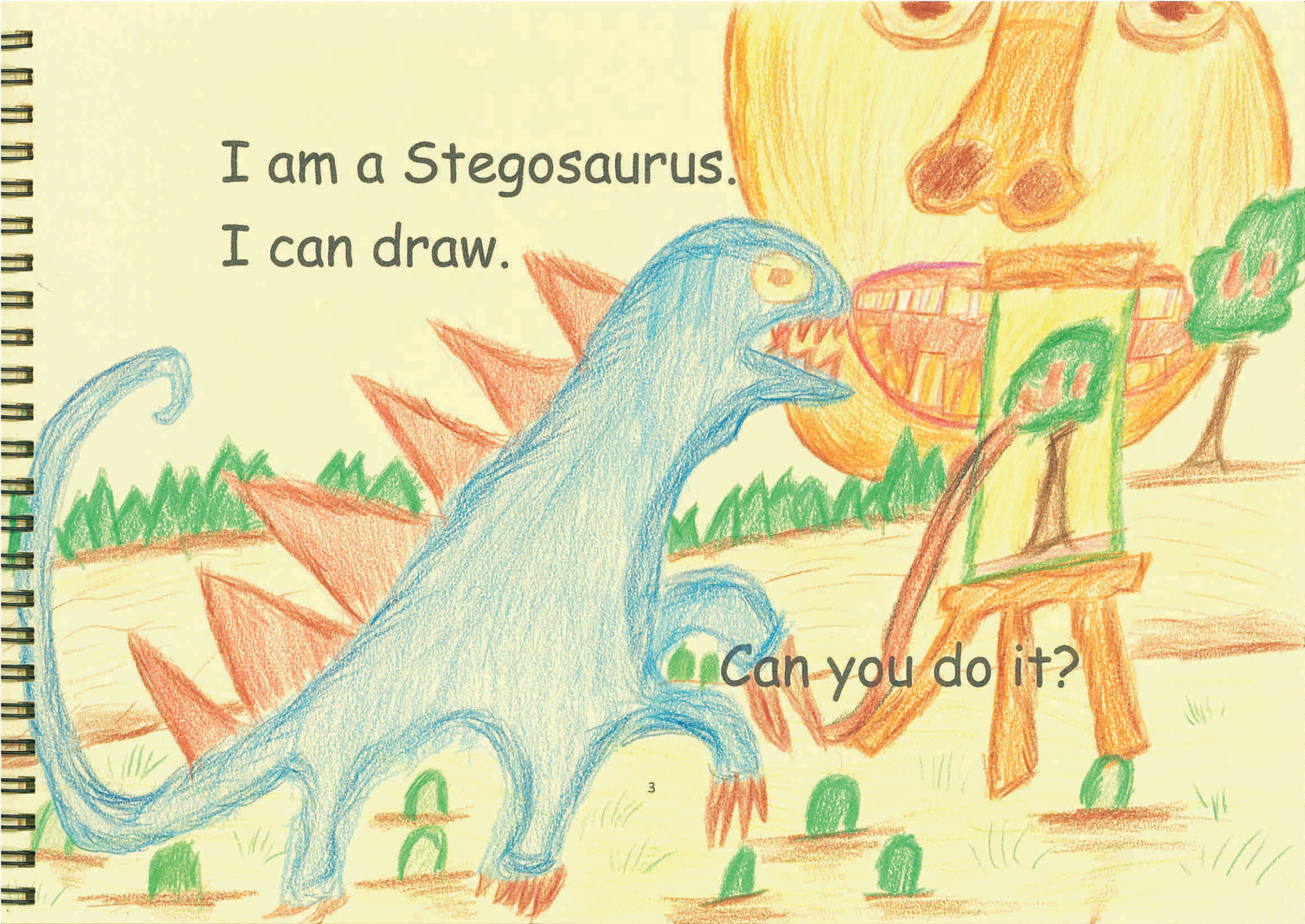

I can dance.

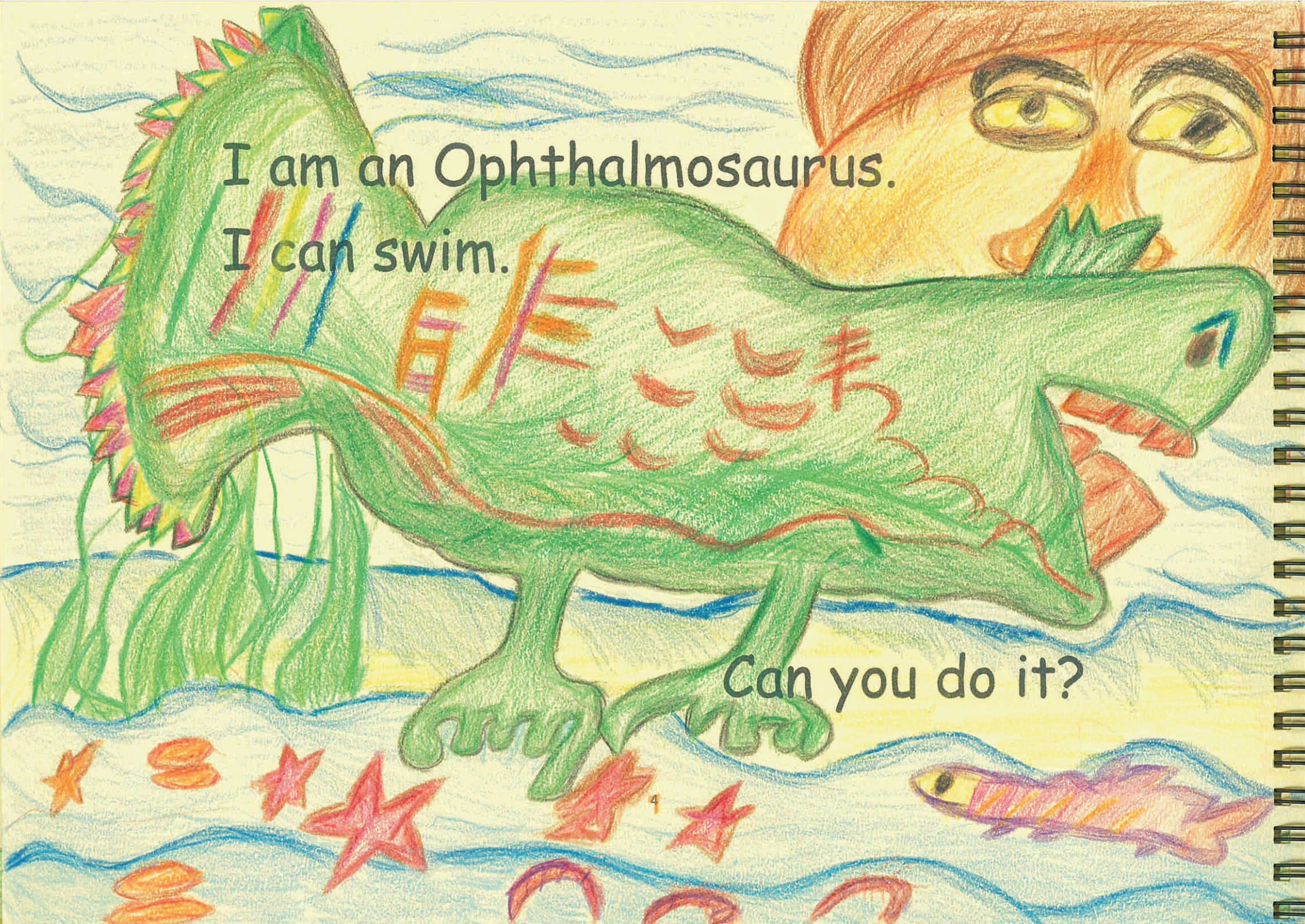

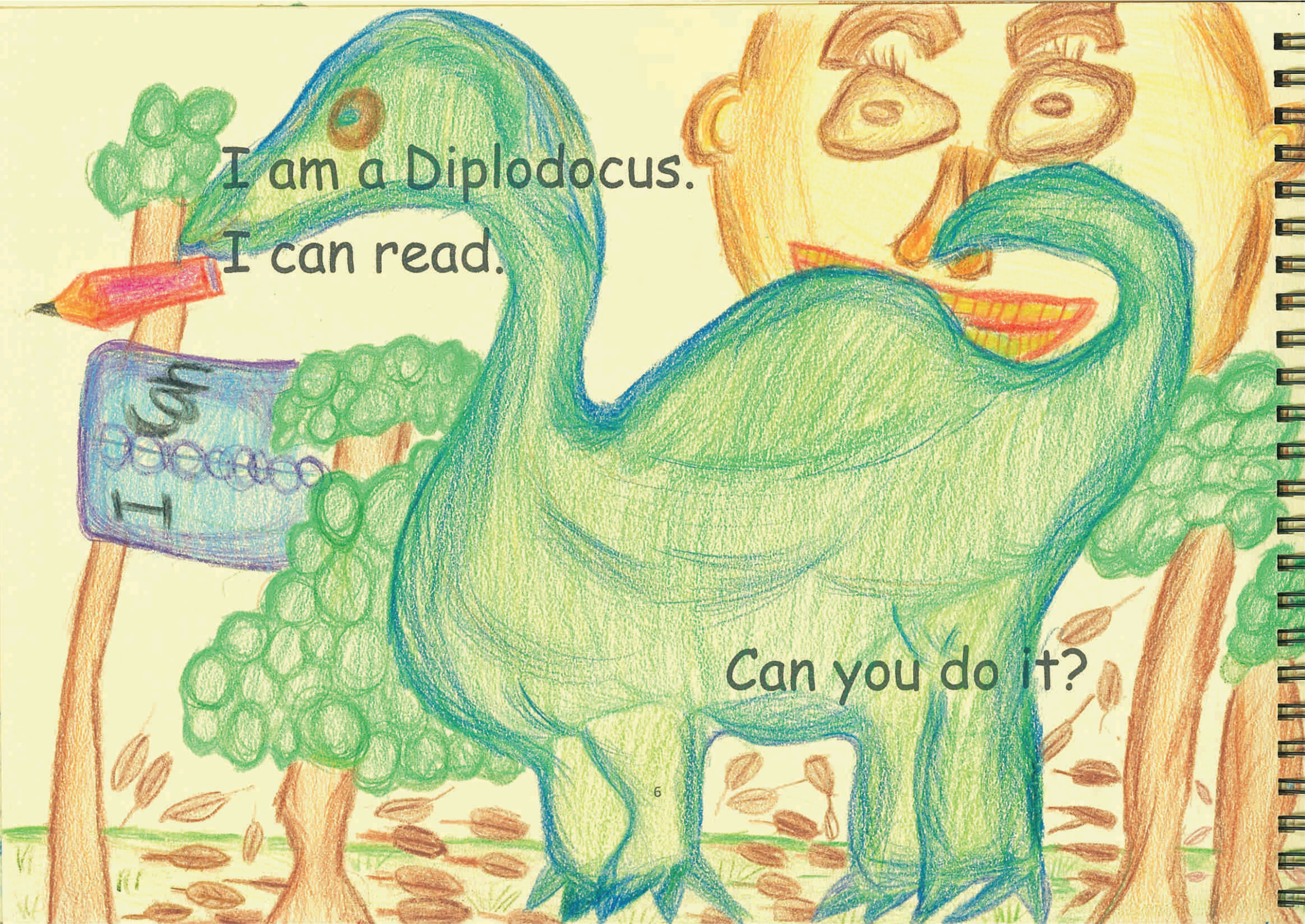

I am a Diplodocus.

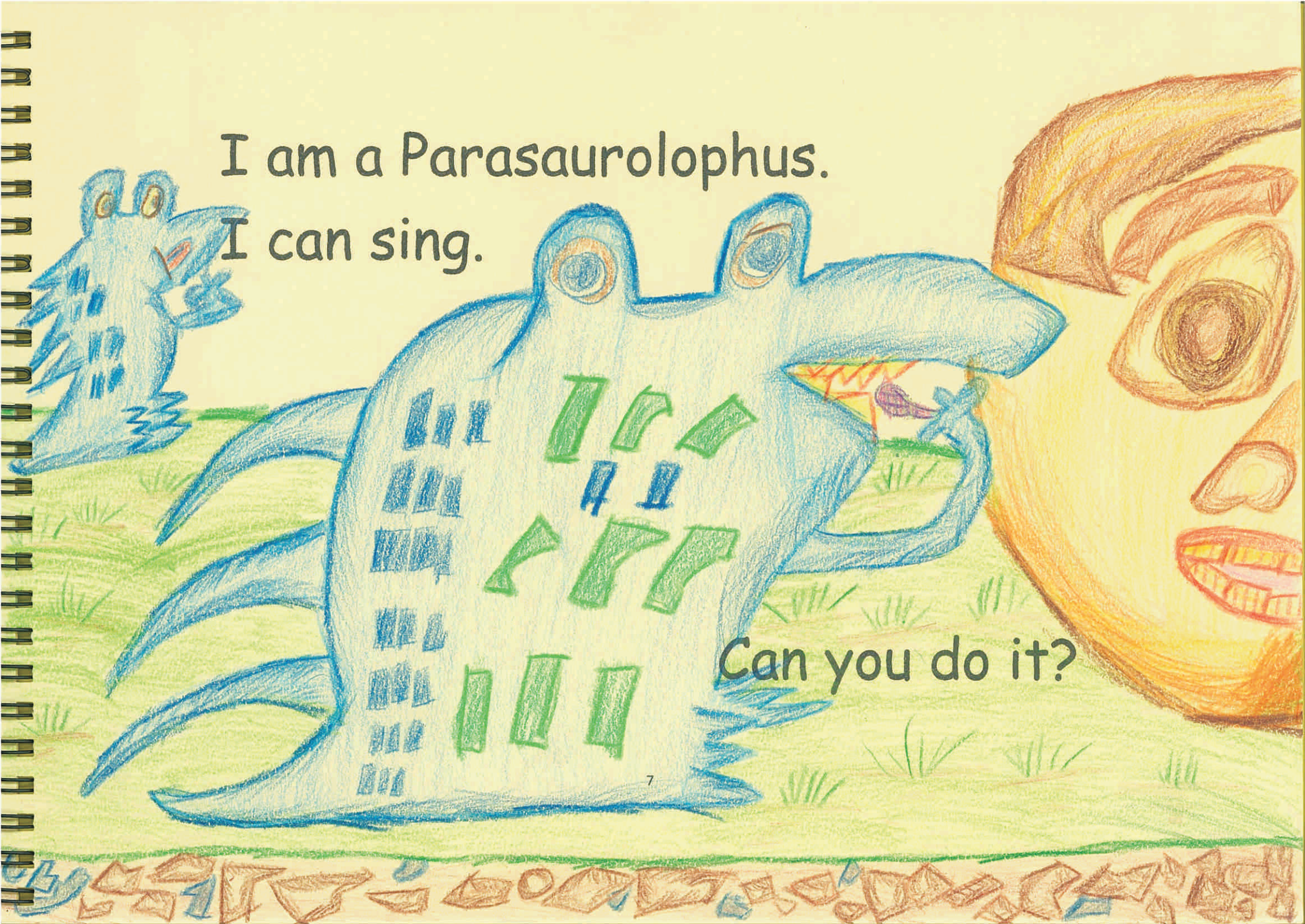

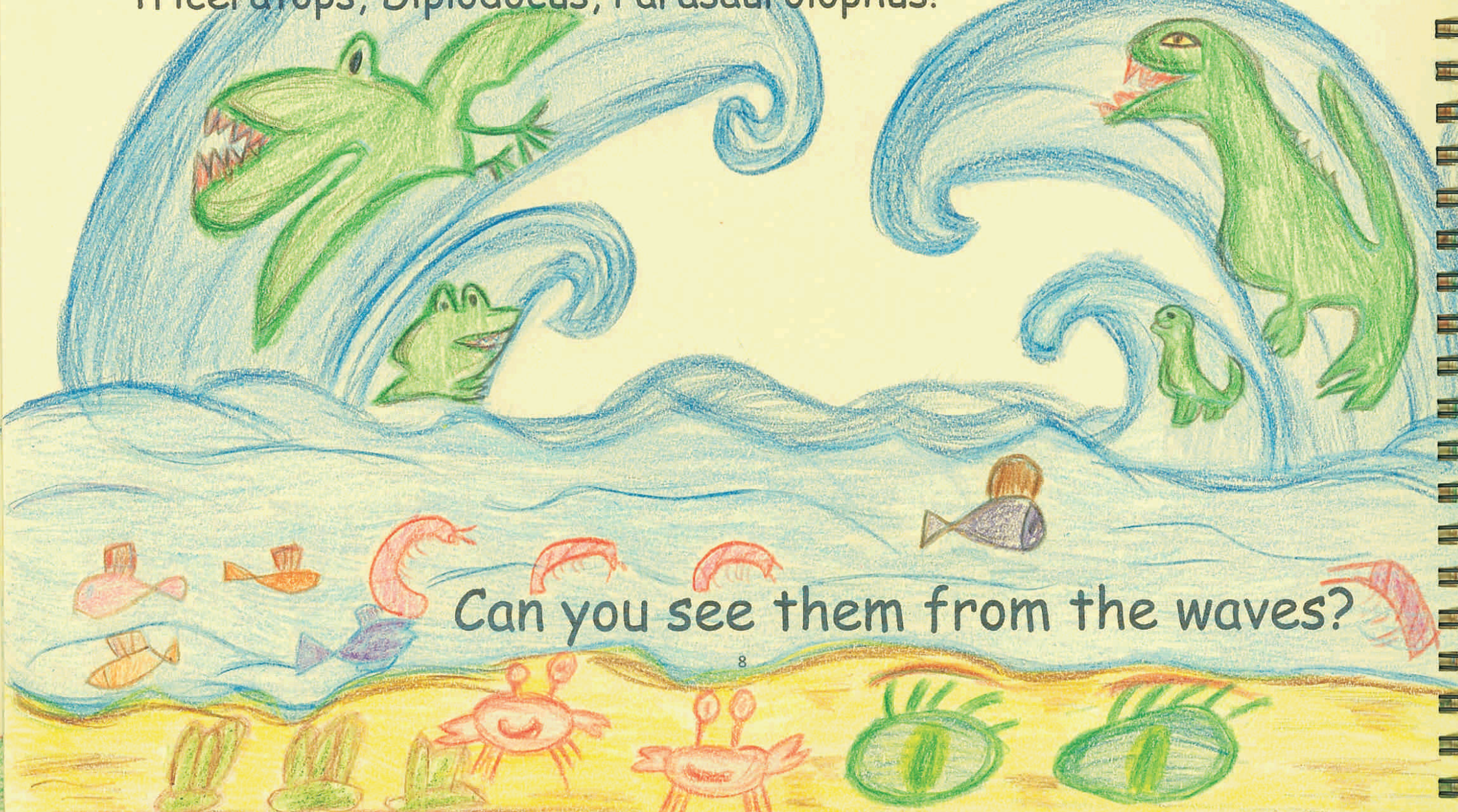
I am a Parasaurolophus.
